Eligibility and application requirements for a Marlins Scholarship:

- 1) Current and future Montrose Marlins Swim Team members may apply.
- 2) If applicant is current or former active member, must be in good standing financially with Marlins at the time of application.
- 3) One application per swimmer.
- 4) Swimmer must show a sincere interest in and commitment to competitive swimming and Marlins practices.
- 5) Swimmer must fully participate in team practices based on swim group (e.g. age group, intermediate, advance age group, elite).
- 6) Swimmer must compete and participate in Marlins home swim meet.
- 7) Swimmer and family representative(s) must participate in at least one (1) Marlins sponsored opportunity and/or activity (e.g. board functions, fundraisers, home swim meet volunteering).
- 8) Members must pay other fees including, but not limited to:
 - a. Marlins annual registration fee, this is the first month dues.
 - b. USA Swimming registration*
 - c. Montrose Community Recreation Center membership*
 - d. Meet fees
 - e. Travel and accommodations
 - f. Swim team gear (e.g. personal suit & goggles)
- 9) The scholarship application must be filled out and submitted with additional required documents which supports swimmer/family/guardian's access to government assistance programs such as proof of financial eligibility to (any of the following):
 - Colorado National School Lunch Program (NSLP), School Breakfast Program (SBP), Colorado WIC Food Program, Colorado Works/TANF Cash Assistance, and Colorado Utility Assistance Program (LEAP), Medicaid, OAP, or other approved assistance program.
